2018 ITINERARY | JUNE 27–JULY 3, 2018 | 7 DAYS | GRADES 6-12

DAY 1: Welcome, Ambassador Leaders!

Arrive on UCLA campus and proceed to registration. Directions for registration will be provided 30 days before the program.

After saying good-byes, parents can attend an *optional* brief orientation, while students join their peers for icebreakers.

Later this evening students enjoy a **welcome dinner and opening address**, and meet teacher leaders who will guide them through the program.

Meet with your group and get to know your teammates as you review the exciting week ahead.

DAY 2: Challenge yourself

Discover the steps to constructing an effective Community Action Plan and learn about the Lead2Feed project your team will develop during the Summit.

Push your limits during a **hands-on team-building experience**. Bond with your team as you solve problems and overcome obstacles together.

Get inspired to go after your dreams by a motivational speaker **Christine Simmons, President & COO of the Los Angeles Sparks and President of the UCLA Alumni Association**.

Begin working on your team project and examine your personal strengths and talents that you bring to the team.

DAY 3: Make a difference

Give back to the local community through a hands-on **service project with United Way**. Learn how this non-profit helps communities across the United States and the world, and how you can make your community action plan go further.

Meet with **UCLA Admissions Officers**, gain insights into the college admissions process and how you can set yourself apart.

Take part in a **College Life Panel with UCLA students** and hear firsthand what college life is really like, then put together your own college wish list.

Create your team identity and decide on the Big Goal for your community that your team will tackle during the Summit.

DAY 4: Create your leadership legacy

Visit the iconic *Disneyland*® Park and discover Walt Disney's secret of making dreams come true. **Take part in a specially designed leadership workshop** and learn how you can discover your personal brand and take ownership for your success.

After the workshop, see Walt Disney's dream in action and explore *Disneyland*® with your friends.

Back on campus, you will develop a vision and action plan for your project, and identify the people you will need to take with you to achieve your Big Goal.

DAY 5: Build your CQ

Examine the issues of prejudice around the world and learn how you can be an agent of change during a multimedia experience at the Museum of Tolerance.

Explore UCLA campus and learn about its unique traditions and culture during a tour led by UCLA students.

During the Global Youth Panel with your peers, consider how you can build your cultural awareness (CQ)—a must-have skill for today's workforce.

In your team meeting, you'll learn how to share your vision in a compelling way and how to overcome barriers for success.

DAY 6: Presentations and celebration – L.A. style!

It's your time to shine! **Present your project** to your peers and teacher leaders. Take the new skills you gained with you and make a difference in your home community.

Explore the vibrant city of Los Angeles, from the hills of Hollywood to sun-soaked beaches. See iconic Grauman's Chinese Theatre and Dolby Theatre, and become a star for a moment on the Hollywood Walk of Fame.

Celebrate your accomplishments and enjoy a special afternoon with your friends at the famous **Santa Monica Pier**.

DAY 7: Go do great things!

In the morning, bid farewell to your friends and teacher leaders. Keep your commitment to be the best leader you can be.
